OBJECTIVE

The objective of this project is to create a book that documents how I became a music fan growing up in my house. I chose songs that either evoke nostalgia or changed my life and design the lyrics (mostly digital and some analogue typography) onto the interior in my house. The book is divided into two chapters that represent my two music phases: pop and rock/metal. For pop music, the pop song lyrics are placed within my living room interior to represent the fun, bright energy of the songs. For rock music, the rock songs are placed within my bedroom interior that are more personal to me. Each song will have a description about how I discovered the song and why I love it or how it changed my life.

I used a brush typeface for the pop songs to make the lyrics playful and fun. For the rock/ metal songs, I used a sharp, gothic typeface to make the lyrics look serious, yet expressive.

























RATIONALE

Since some of the lyrics were not standing out against the background and looked too forced to like real on the interior, I decided to blur the background, use brighter colours to create more contrast, extend the lyrics outside the composition to make it look more digital.



OBJECTIVE

Since those compositions weren't working, I decided to not skew or distort the lyrics and instead, just overlap and blend them on top of the interior photos to create more hierarchy. Also to create a colour palette for each chapter. For pop songs, I used blue and green to represent how my childhood was fresh and lively. For rock/metal songs, I used pink and red to represent my maturity and adulthood. Plus, I added the song titles and body text about the discovery and significance of the song that it has on my life. The songs where I create the lyrics analogue are left blank to still create.




us slipknot
